Economic realities are forcing elected officials to adjust budget expenditures, but nobody is doing the work to understand how Minnesota military veterans are coping through it all.



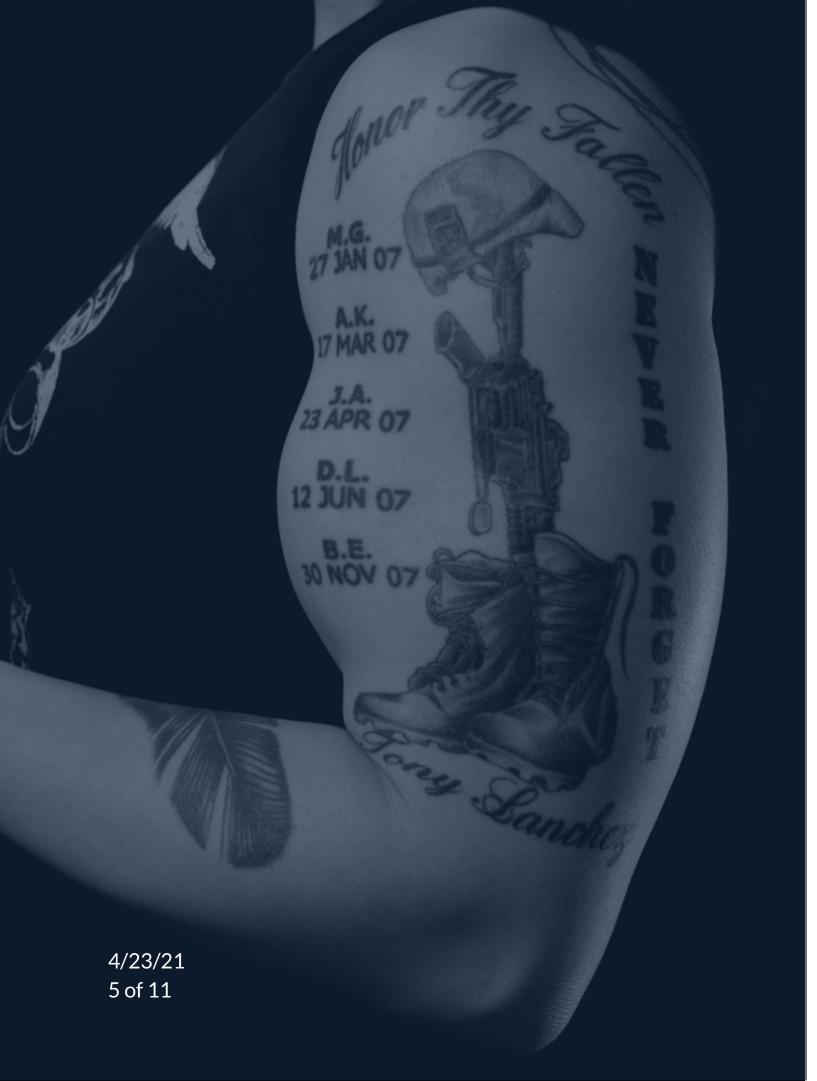
# THE SOLUTION

# MINNESOTA VETERANS WELLNESS SURVEY

UVLC is organizing a statewide campaign to contact military veterans across Minnesota with a resources and resiliency survey. Think of it like a SITREP or a SALUTE report after enemy contact. We need to find out "WHO needs WHAT" and "WHO can HELP". Due to the effects of lockdowns and the closing of services and businesses, we believe it's critical to understand the specifics of what individual veterans and their families are going through.







# **OUR COMMITMENTS**

Military veterans and those now in uniform chose to serve their country. They served us. Some were harmed. All were forever changed. We pledged to care for them and their families.

Recently, more veterans and their families have been harmed. We who love and serve Minnesota's military veterans know that we must take action, but the extent of damage is unclear.

#### We need to find out what is happening to individuals and their families:

Do they have children at home? How are the children doing? Are they caring for someone at home? Are they helping others? Are they well or unwell? Discouraged? Demoralized?

#### We need to find out about their livelihood and savings:

Are they able to cover living expenses?
Impending expenses, medical bills?
Are they at risk for becoming "unsheltered"?
What sort of assistance would make sense?
Have they been asked?

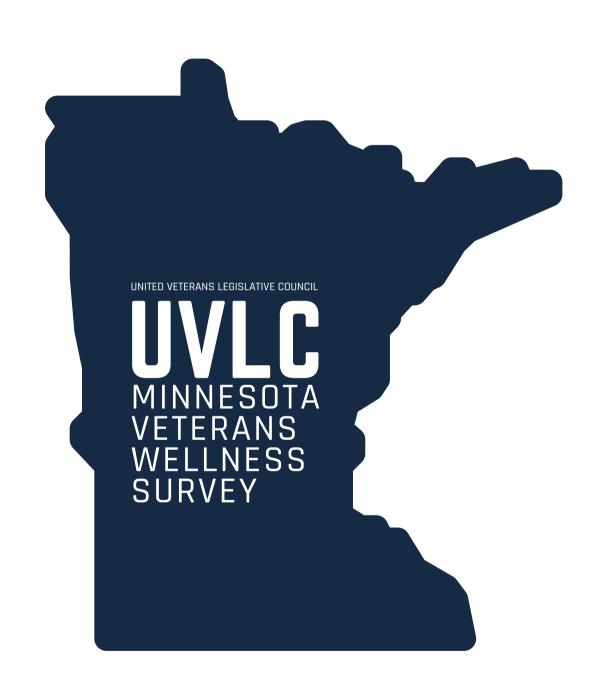
